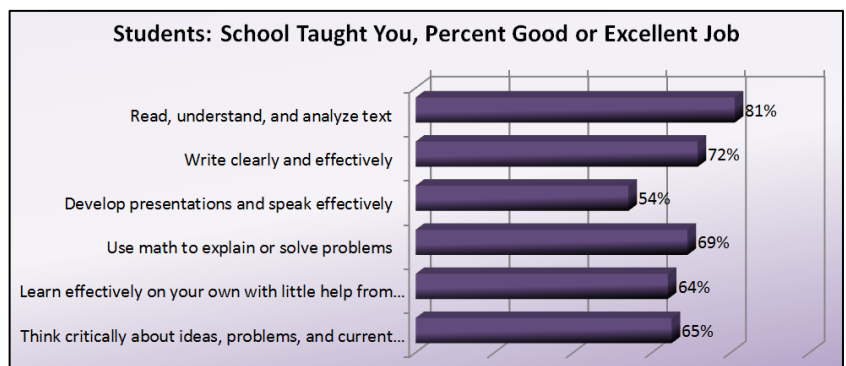
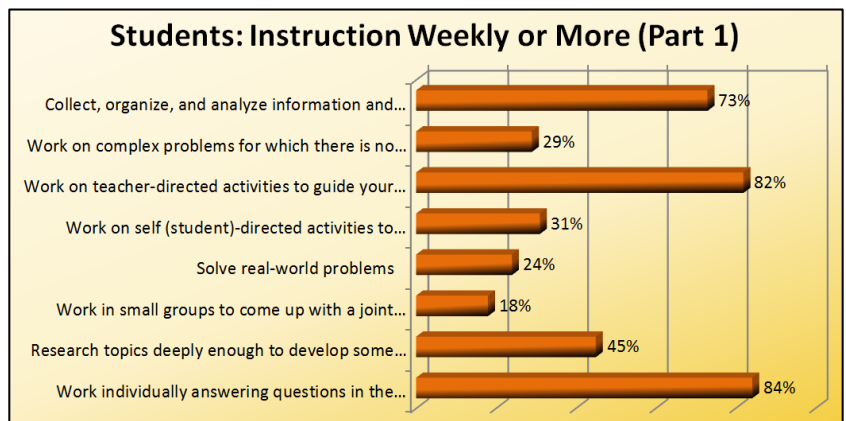
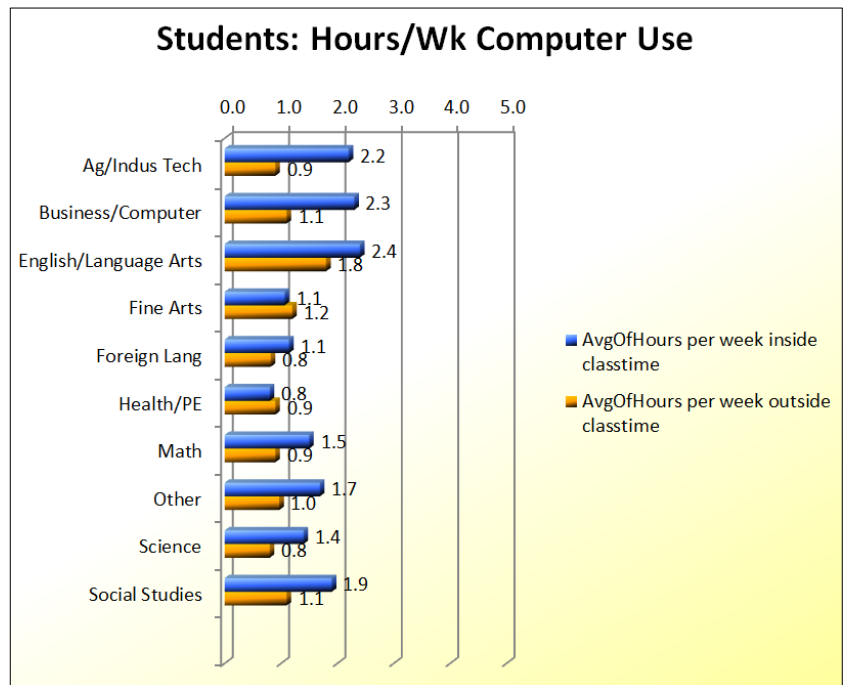


# In the age of data-driven decision-making, why do we have so little data to work with?

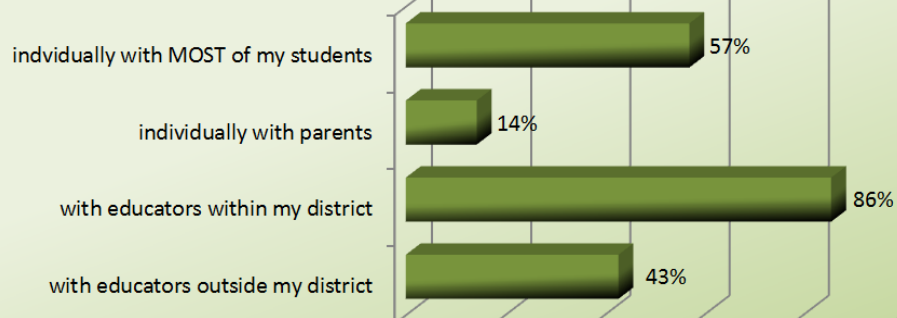

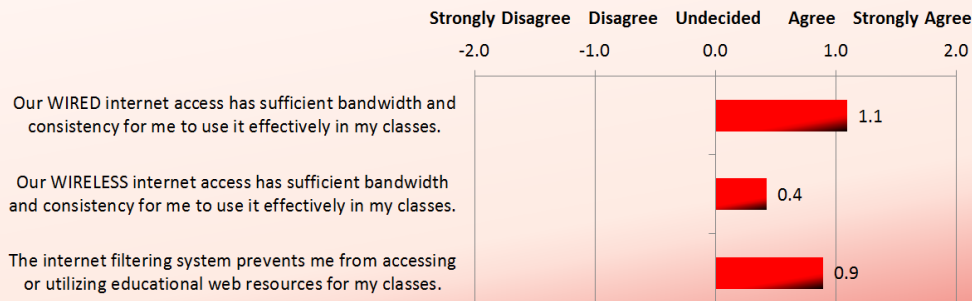


## Teachers: Use Tech to Interact, % Weekly or More



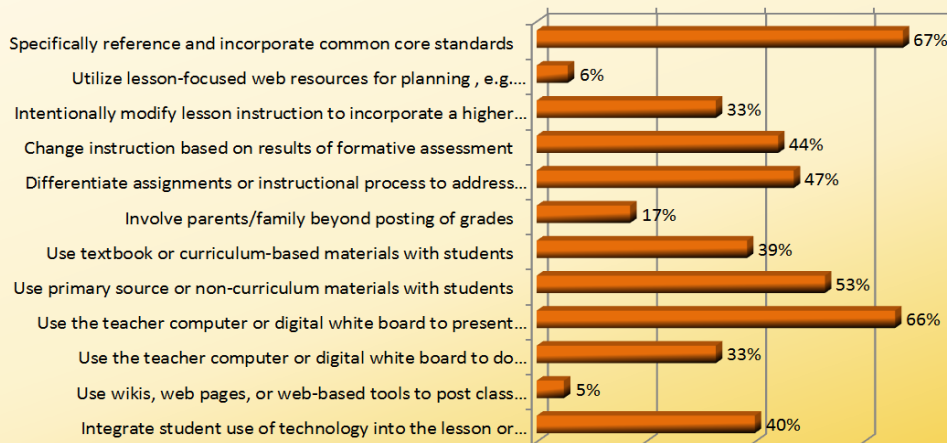
